Their mission is to facilitate hope and reconciliation through music, cross-cultural relationships, and individual artist development. By recognizing that each of us is worthy of love and understanding, we can bridge the ideological, racial, and socioeconomic gaps that divide us, and live together as citizens of the world. At Messiah, we love walking with children and youth on their journeys to follow Jesus. To do that, we offer several Sunday morning classes: Children in pre-K through 5th grade gather for KID Street Sunday School at 8:30 and 10:30 am. Kids begin in worship, are released to Sunday School mid-service, and can be picked up downstairs after worship. Youth in grades 6-8 will gather in the Youth Room for Sunday School during both the 8:30 and 10:30 am worship services. Youth begin in worship and are dismissed with the kids midservice. Youth Sunday School offers age-appropriate teaching that follows the sermon series and scripture stories used in Sunday worship. The nursery, for infants and toddlers (through age 3), is available at both services, and these children may be dropped off downstairs in KID Street HQ before worship begins. All children and youth are always welcome to remain in the sanctuary if your family prefers to worship together.

For those with t-coil equipped hearing aids or cochlear implants, an **induction hearing loop** is installed for use in our sanctuary.
